

Optimized large volume production of automotive components Horizontal machining center "FF-5000/40"

Yamazaki Mazak Corporation has announced the start of sales of the compact #40 taper spindle horizontal machining center, the "FF-5000/40", which is designed for the mass-production of automotive components. This machine will be displayed at the 13TH international machine tool & tooling exhibition (CIMES) in Beijing, China (Jun. 22-26th).

Production equipment used for the high-volume machining of automotive components require high productivity, high reliability, extremely convenient maintenance, and the integration with high performance automation.

The new FF-5000/40 is designed to provide unsurpassed performance in meeting the above important requirements. The high speed acceleration of the X, Y, and Z axes ensures high productivity. Reliability is assured by the Direct ATC system (tools are directly changed to/from the spindle to the tool magazine) which has a much smaller number of components when compared to a normal tool changer system. The spindle cartridge or slideway covers are easily changed to minimize the production downtime required for maintenance. This compact machine with fixed table design can easily be integrated in automated production lines designed for large volume production.
