

Opening of the new Poznan Technical Center in Poland

The new Poznan Technical Center was opened in northwestern Poland as the second Mazak Technical Center in Poland in May.

Northwestern Poland with its proximity to Germany is a key location for advanced manufacturing across the automotive, aerospace, construction machinery and agricultural machinery industries. To provide enhanced before and after sales service and support to customers in this growing region of Central Europe, the new Technical Center was established in Poznan.

The Poland Technology Center in Katowice in southern Poland was opened in 2012 and provides technical support to customers in Poland. With the addition of this second new facility, Mazak will provide improved support to customers throughout Poland.

The new facility occupies a total floor space of approximately 400m⁺, including the 270m⁺ demonstration area with the latest Mazak machine tools and laser processing machines, as well as a classroom and offices. It will provide customer programming classes, machine demonstrations and test cuts.

The new Poznan Technical Center is the latest member of the Mazak global support network that has been established to provide sales, service and technical support to customers all over the world.
