

Completion of New South East Asia Technology Center and New Factory Expansion

Yamazaki Mazak Corporation (President: Tomohisa Yamazaki, Address: Oguchi-cho, Niwa-gun, Aichi-pref) has completed the construction of a new Technology Center and a factory expansion of Yamazaki Mazak Singapore Pte., Ltd. and held a Grand Opening ceremony on March 19, 2014 in Singapore. Yamazaki Mazak Singapore Pte., Ltd. was established in 1988 as a support base for the sales and service of Mazak Machine Tools.

The Technology Center and Factory opened in 1992, and first produced tool units for machine tools. In 1996, the factory was expanded and started to manufacture machine tools which were exported to mainly South East Asian countries, as well Japan, Europe, and North and South America.

The object fifth expansion

As a part of improving the global manufacturing and supporting system that was started much earlier than other Japanese machine tool manufacturers, Mazak aims to offer more customer-oriented support to their customers in the South East Asian region, and to establish a manufacturing system that will increase the export of machine tools to worldwide markets. This production expansion will shorten delivery time and cushion exchange rate fluctuations by expanding the Technology Center and factory.

About 300 guests were invited to the Grand Opening ceremony on March 19, including Mr. Teo Ser Luck, Minister of State at the Ministry of Trade and Industry, the Singapore Economic Development Board, the Embassy of Japan in Singapore, as well guests from South East Asia and Japan.
